The supplier stated the trees were harvested in an eco-friendly manner, utilizing only manpower and provided photographic evidence in support.

We purchased this Ebony between 2006 and 2008 and selected superior cut and quality cants, otherwise destined for the veneer industry. Then they were transported to our facility, sawn to planks, air-dried and resawn into tonewood components. To the best of our knowledge, the harvest, export and import of this item was in compliance with all applicable laws.
