This old growth Western Big Leaf Maple was salvaged from the forests of SW Oregon.

We only select trees that are standing dead or dying, blown down by wind or had been cut and left behind by the timber companies in their pursuit of Fir and Spruce. The trees from SW Oregon yield wood, which is often highly colored.

The salvaged stumps and trunk sections were carefully removed from the forest, transported to our miller, allowed to cure, sawn into slabs, air-dried and resawn into tonewood parts. To the best of our knowledge, the acquisition and harvest of this item was in compliance with all applicable laws.
