


Certificate of Source

We hereby certify the
Redwood tonewood utilized in this instrument
Oregon Wild Wood item # _____, was sourced as follows:

This old growth Redwood tonewood was salvaged from trees cut over a century ago in the N. California coastal forests. These were the legendary 1500 to 2000+ year old giants that grew to 20' diameter and over 400' tall. The stumps from these trees, and the occasional trunk section left in the forest, stayed perfectly preserved over the past century and the wood is of distinctly high quality.

These salvaged stump and trunk sections were carefully removed from the forest, transported to Oregon, sawn into slabs, air-dried and resawn into tonewood parts. To the best of our knowledge, the acquisition and harvest of this item was in compliance with all applicable laws.
